Professional Activities:

Pedro Correia de Barros started his professional activity in 1971 in the Department of Economic Studies of Banco de Fomento Nacional – Lisbon

In 1972, he entered the Animal Feed Area as executive director of Fábrica de Rações da Beira S.A., progressively scaling his way up to the position of C.E.O. of Grupo Nutroton SGPS S.A., in 2004.

The activities of Grupo Nutroton are related to the incubation and commercialization of day old chicks and pullets, egg production and commercialization, renewable energies, special units in civil and industrial building, and to the commercialization of agro-frozen products, with companies in Portugal, Spain and Angola.

Since 1975, the Group is associated to industrial aviculture, by means of incubation, production and commercialization of eggs, slaughter (until 1991) and production of egg by-products.

Association Activities:

Pedro Correia de Barros has been linked to IACA since 1976, as Director between 1976/1981 and 2000/2005, President of the General Assembly from 1991 to 1997 and Chairman of the Board of Directors from 1982 to 1984 and, again since 2006.

Member of the FEFAC Council between 1982/1984 and since 2006, and also member of the Economic and Environmental Issues Commission since 2000.

He's the current President of FEFAC.

Member of the COPA's Working Groups on Birds and Eggs and of the Advisory Committees for Birds and Eggs of the European Community Commission from 1987 to 1995.

Between 1989/1991 he was a Board member of AVEC.

President of ANAPO (Associação dos Produtores de Ovos – *Egg Producers Association*) from 1985 to 1990 and President of FEPASA (Aviculture Federation) between 1990/1991.

In 2006, he was appointed Director of FIPA (Federation of Agriculture and Food Industries).
